Comment

With the on-going SARS-CoV-2 pandemic a wide range of hand sanitisers have been released worldwide. Many of these are produced by manufacturers who do not have the experience or expertise of Christeyns and some products may cause drying of skin or be ineffective due to the low level of alcohol.

A [report](#) by ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) indicated that a large number of hand sanitiser products on the market were “ineffective or illegal” and withdrawals have been ordered in both Europe and in the US by the FDA.

The extension of BS EN 14885 to include hygienic hand rubs has been implemented by the BSI to enable users to be assured that a product that is Kitemarked meets the highest standards.
